Furthermore the course will be interesting for employees from certification bodies, sector associations, consultancy organisations or (non-) governmental organisations.

Level

The course is at BSc level; basic knowledge is required. Participants who are not familiar with the basics of the oils and fats supply chain are recommended to first attend the MVO Academy Course: 'Basics of Oils and Fats'. The language of the course will be English. Participants will receive a certificate on successfully completing the course.
